



Subject: Dental Claim Forms

Scope: Unison MedPLUS, Unison Kids & Unison Advantage

Effective February 1, 2008, the American Dental Association (ADA) Claim Form – Version 2006 will be accepted by Unison Health Plan. All providers are urged to report their NPI number by utilizing this form.

Unison Kids & Unison Advantage:

Dental claims that are received on or after May 23, 2008 that do not have a valid NPI in block 49 & 54 of Version 2006 will be denied.

Unison MedPLUS:

Dental claims that are received on or after August 1, 2008 that do not have a valid NPI in block 49 & 54 of Version 2006 will be denied.
