Medications are identified for addition to Unison's Quality Management Drug Program from a variety of sources including current literature reviews, consultation with practicing physicians and pharmacists who serve in Unison's service area and who possess a wide range of specialized medical expertise, governmental agency policies (i.e. U.S. Food and Drug Administration [FDA]), as well as national accreditation organization standards. The list of agents included in the program is revised and updated annually and more frequently as new evidence becomes available that prompts needed revisions.
